The scope of the program is presendet:

1. 30 ECTS for Multilingual Education Module from 300 ECTS of integrated BA/MA Program of Teacher Education.
2. Module Integrated in the Module of Intensive School Practice (60 ECTS).

The program structure is presented also:

Compulsory Courses of Multilingual Education Module

- Problems and Models of Multilingual Education- 6 ECTS;
- Teaching Methods of Georgian as a Second Language -Language Skills and Assessment - 6 ECTS;

- Teaching Methods of Georgian as a Second Language -Language Aspects and Assessment - 6 ECTS;

- **Content and Language Integrated Learning (CLIL)**

(one of three courses of own choice):

- Pre-School Level and Elementary School Level: Arts, Music, Sports
- Secondary School Level (Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology)
- Secondary School Level 4: History, Geography, Civic Education

Elective Courses

- Social and Cultural Aspects of Multilingual Education - 6 ECTS;
- Psychological aspects of bilingual teaching - 6 ECTS;
- Language Courses with subject terminology - 3 ECTS;
- Internet Resources in CLIL - 3 ECTS (blended learning on electronic learning portal: www.moodle.iliauni.edu.ge) - 3 ECTS .
